PLEASE, NO STREAM DUMPING

The leaves will be falling before we know it! Soon there will be no more bagging of leaves, clippings, or brush. When conducting fall cleanup, please remember to remember to properly dispose of yard waste.

Even though it may be tempting to dump your yard waste at the banks of a nearby stream, down a ravine, or leave along a storm sewer; this is considered storm water pollution.

When yard waste breaks down, it depletes the water of oxygen and causes organisms - including fish and aquatic insects - to die off.

Yard waste contains a large amount of nutrients, which can also lead to the increased growth of algae in our waterways. Algae can too consume all the oxygen in the water and cause foul odors.

When cutting the grass, use a mulching mower to leave the grass clippings on your lawn and put nutrients back into the soil. We can all do our part to keep Mentor's waterways clean.

Aid and Attendance Benefit: A Little Known Veterans Resource

While it is not as well-known as many other military benefits, the VA Aid and Attendance benefit provides much needed assistance to individuals who require the regular care of another person to help with bathing, meal preparation, dressing, medication monitoring and other activities of daily living. This tax-free benefit is provided by the Department

of Veterans Affairs and may be available to Veterans and their surviving spouses who live in assisted living communities, residential care homes and those receiving personal in-home care.

To qualify, a Veteran must have served at least 90 days of consecutive active-duty service. He or she must have been discharged with any

type of discharge other than a dishonorable discharge. They must also have served one day of active duty during wartime to be eligible for this benefit. Also eligible are Reservist or National Guard Veterans activated during wartime for 90 days and surviving spouses of Veterans if married at the time of their Veteran's death.

Eligible Veterans must be age 65 or older or totally disabled or a resident or patient in a skilled nursing facility due to loss of mental or physical abilities or getting Social Security Disability Insurance or Supplemental Security Income. For a surviving spouse, there is no age requirement.

As of July 1, 2021, the maximum Aid and Attendance Benefits are as follows:

Veteran: up to \$1936/month.

Surviving spouse: up to \$1244/month

Married veteran: up to \$2295/month

Married veteran couple: up to \$3071/month

Proof of the need for assistance with activities of daily living is required. Certain income qualifications also apply, however most unreimbursed expenses such as insurance premiums, the cost of assisted living, nursing home, or in-home care can help reduce the counted income. Other qualifications may apply but each case is decided on the facts of the individual's circumstances.

AEP - Annual Election Period

The annual election period for Medicare is coming up October 15th through December 7th. This period also called Medicare open enrollment is a time for Medicare enrollees to review & reevaluate their current coverage and makes changes if necessary

for the upcoming year. Changes made during this period become effective January 1st.

Prior to AEP the Medicare beneficiary enrolled in a Medicare Advantage or Part D prescription drug plan will receive an annual notice of change or ANOC. This notice details changes in their plan for the next calendar year.

During this period, a beneficiary can switch from one Medicare Advantage plan to another, switch from Medicare Advantage to Original Medicare, switch from Original Medicare to a Medicare Advantage plan, enroll in a Medicare Part D prescription drug plan, switch to another Part D plan or drop Part D coverage.

Open enrollment does not apply to medigap or supplemental plans.



There's More to Mold Than Just the Spore!

Mold can emit a fungal gas! When particular molds colonize and they progress through their life cycle they emit a gas (musty smell). As the reservoir of fungus grows to several billion spores in the colony, our noses detect the smell of these fungal gases.

When a closed indoor environment continues to fill with the mycotoxic gases, they can become a health risk. The affect it has on the human body is dependent on three variables. Our individual immune systems, the type of spore and the volume of fungal gas, determines the impact on our bodies.

Additionally, the longer the exposure to these gases, the greater the likely hood we will develop a sensitivity. Much like other environmental allergens we are exposed to, the longer the exposure, the greater the chance our bodies will have an adverse reaction.

With a little effort, we can reduce or eliminate this health hazard by using a disinfectant or removing the affected material. In some instances, it may be necessary to seek a professional opinion or get professional help.
