The Annual Arizona Distracted Driving Summit (ADDS) on January 23, 2019 in Phoenix, AZ, will be facilitated by a dedicated coalition of statewide volunteers and organizations. The Summit will focus on three key components needed to end distracted driving: Education, Engagement, and Enforcement.
