Hello Church!

This gave me a lot of wonderful evenings to attend to things outside on the property like creating a yard, removing brush and making a little walking trail in the trees.

There were so many mild temperature days that were great for working outside that I found myself at times putting off various things on my to-do list because the next day would be just as nice. As we now start to experience the heat and humidity of the summer months, I wish I could go back and reclaim some of those temperate evenings.

I'm sure we have all had things we put off only to later wish we had taken advantage of the time or opportunity when it was presented. Paul writes to the church in Ephesus in Ephesians 5:15-16 "Be very careful, then, how you live—not as unwise but as wise, making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil." Paul is not simply speaking of worldly tasks that need to be completed but of the Heavenly tasks God presents to us and calls us toward in our walk with Jesus.

Paul says the "days are evil" meaning time is not always our friend. Just like when we procrastinate on school work or projects time marches on leaving those days unable to be reclaimed. Paul's advice is for Christians to claim the moments God presents to us each day. To live in such a way that we are willing and ready to serve others, grow in our faith, and step out into what God has prepared for us.

It's confronting to get laud into thinking there is plenty of time, then we don't have to act in the moment because there will always be tomorrow. But just as we all have experienced putting things off until tomorrow only to wish we would have acted sooner, the same is true in our spiritual lives.

What are the things God has been placing on your heart that you have been waiting to respond? Maybe waiting for the illusive perfect moment or just being too busy to respond today? Isaiah 55:6 says, "Seek the LORD while He may be found; call on Him while He is near." God is calling; may we find ourselves ready and eager to respond today making the most of all the opportunities God is placing before us and see the blessing of an alert and awake life!






