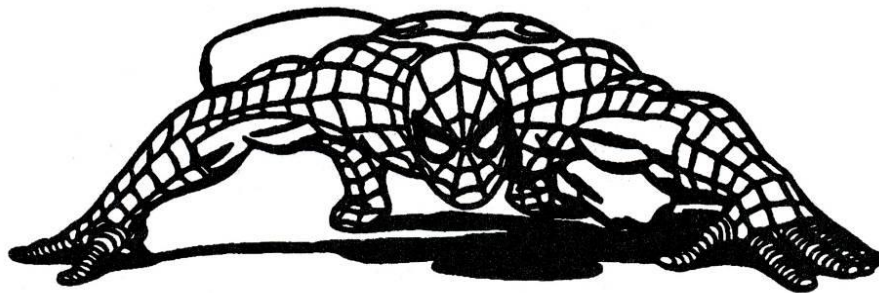
On the front of the cover, I placed some spider webs from the old Spider-Man comic books from the 70s and 80s. In front of the fantastic Spider-Man spider webs in the lower left portion of the cover, I placed Spider-Man himself. Then, in the lower right portion of the cover, I placed a red spider with some webbing shooting out of its behind.



I also decided to create some images on the back of my cover. As you can see in Figure 2, I used the “Amazing Spider-Man 2” billboard, which features Spider-Man, Electro, The Green Goblin, and the Rhino.

After deciding where to put all of these Amazing Spider-Man 2 pictures, I printed my Spectacular Spider-Man envelopes.
