Location: Rockford, Illinois

Dates: March 2018- December 2018

Pre-requisites: 30 undergrad hours in Agriculture, Communications,
or Education
(Ag communications or Ag education preferred)

Requirements: Minimum of 300 hrs. Minimum of 20 hrs./week (summer)
Minimum of 100 hrs. (winter) and 30 hours (spring)

Value: Up to \$2500 to be paid at conclusion of internship (summer)
Up to \$750 (winter) and \$300 (spring)

Responsibilities:

- Promote and coordinate Ag-in-the-Classroom projects
- Assist with the planning of a week-long, graduate credit Summer Ag Institute for teachers.
- Assist with public relations efforts through newsletters, press releases and other correspondence
- Coordinate County Fair activities with volunteer committees
- Inventory, checkout and track educational materials
- Assist with fundraising for the comprehensive Ag Ed program in Boone and Winnebago counties.
