Masters Class - for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who at the time entries close have won 10 first place awards in an Open Class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition.

Notice

Juniors who substitute for the original dog they have entered in the Junior Showmanship classes with a dog that is not entered in one of the offered classes at this show must remit the Junior Show only entry fee with their substitution. Juniors who win a third Novice Class with competition present may transfer their entry into the Open Class provided that the transfer is made at the Show Secty's desk at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

At the judges' discretion, the Desert Valley Dachshund Club offers Awards of Merit to the quality Dachshunds that are serious competition for the top awards. It is entirely the judge's discretion whether to give all of the available Awards of Merit, some or none at all. Awards of Merit are selected from the dogs and bitches in each Best of Variety Competition, other than the Best of Variety and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Variety winners.

There will be a special Rosette for each Award of Merit.

The number of Awards available in each variety is determined by the number competing in its BOV competition.

- 1 Award of Merit 6-8 competing in BOV Competition
- 2 Awards of Merit 9-12 competing in BOV Competition
- 3 Awards of Merit 13 & over competing in BOV Competition

after which time no entries may be accepted, canceled, changed, substituted, corrected, or signed and no entry fees refunded. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the AKC Dog Show Rules.

The Desert Valley Dachshund Club and their Show Secretary assume no responsibility for a wrong entry. Entries will not be accepted without proper fees and signatures. Entries must be submitted on approved entry forms with the agreement printed on the reverse side. Photocopies of front & back will be accepted if legible. Exhibitors are advised to Type or print all unusual words when filling in entry forms.

THESE SHOWS are governed by the American Kennel Club. Exhibitors should read the AKC agreement on the backside of the entry form in this Premium List.

No entry fee will be refunded for Bitches who come in season after the close of entries for this show, or for a dog that is absent, sick, lame, disqualified or excused by Veterinarian, Judge or Bench Show Committee. No entry fees will be returned if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, strikes or any other causes beyond the control of the management. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry. There will be a \$3.00 fee charged for cancellation of an entry prior to closing of entries.

Note: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. RETURNED CHECKS will be charged a \$30.00 collection fee. The returned check and fee must be paid with Cash at the Show Secretary's desk or office BEFORE the dog will be allowed in the ring. Dogs need not be at the show until the scheduled time of judging. Dogs no longer needed for further judging will be excused. This show is unbenched.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring, if provided.

The Club, the San Marcos Hotel, the Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc. will not be responsible for the loss of or injury to any dog or the possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result of accident or other causes. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the Show premises. And, in addition, no responsibility will be assumed for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an owner, exhibitor, handler or spectator. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is expressly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children at all times.

Trophies and Class cash prizes will be awarded in the judging ring to the person showing the dog. In the event of any discrepancy from the published prize list, the Show Chairman should be advised at once. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed. The Show Secretary and the Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging is over.

RECORDING & EVENT FEES include the 50¢ AKC Recording Fee and the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single-entry classes. There is no recording fee or event service fee for sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions. (AKC Rule, Ch 11, Sec 2).

TRANSFERS TO BEST OF BREED Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a Championship after the closing of entries for the Show but whose Championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the start of the earliest conformation judging at the Show.

ALL RIGHTS TO PHOTOGRAPH, video, televise, advertise, or otherwise promote this show are vested in the Club or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club.
