

September 11, 2014 - Our speaker was Ms. Rebecca Hudson, Director of Outreach and Social Media, NASA Wallops Island Flight Facility, Virginia. Ms. Hudson described various aspects of Wallops, including the mission, staff, physical facility, equipment, etc. Few of us in the audience realized that Wallops encompasses 6000 acres and employs almost 1100 people. The equipment there includes the large Global Hawk drone, which has a wing span of 130 feet. Wallops launches vehicles as tall as a 13 story building. Ms. Hudson noted that they are currently working with Ocean City to establish a launch viewing site in Ocean City on the boardwalk near the Life Saving Museum.
