## Medication

If your child is taking **ANY** medication, prescribed or otherwise, or using an asthma inhaler, it is extremely important that you notify your keyperson immediately. In situations where it may be necessary to call in the emergency services, we will be asked what medication the child is taking so it is imperative that we be given this information.

#### Kent Education Sustainable Citizenship Bronze Award

We have been chosen by KCC to pilot the above scheme and have been informed that due to our earlier sustainability projects, we are now half way to achieving an Award. To help us achieve the Bronze Award we shall be sending home "I Can" booklets to children in the Lions Class. These booklets contain tasks such as going to the post office, sharing stories, recognising healthy eating etc., which can be completed at home by the children alongside their parents. Stickers and praise at Circle Time will be issued at the end of each task when the books are returned. Further schemes can then lead to Silver and Gold Awards. #### Lunches

Please also remember to clearly mark the lunchbox with your child's name.

Following FSA guidelines, we will remove any out of date items that we find in your child's lunchbox. As we have several children at Pre-School with nut allergies, please DO NOT give your child any nuts or nut based products in their lunchboxes.
