The purpose of VHVH is to continue our community's obligation to serve our veterans by restoring a foundation of home, health and spirit and transition them from net consumers of services to net contributors of resources to our community. We operate with a focus on delivering positive outcomes in an efficient manner and I'd like to note some of our most recent accomplishments.

- **We've designed and implemented our program**, which focuses on life skills, executive functions, workforce development, and transition planning.
- **85% of our veterans have steady employment or income through our VHVH Works™ employment partnerships.** Participating partners include the Winston-Salem Dash at BB&T Ballpark, Spectra Food Services at Wake Forest University, Rhino Sports and Entertainment Services at Virginia Tech University, and Ezekiel AME Zion Church's Summer Food Program.
- **87% are enrolled in education or job skills training partnerships** at places like Forsyth Tech Community College and Goodwill Industries of North West North Carolina.
- **And 80% of our graduates are moving into permanent housing.**

I tell our growing community of supporters that we have one of the best alumni networks in Winston-Salem, North Carolina of veterans eager to serve and contribute to our local community. I continue to share these stories with our partners and future supporters about the great work that is being done at VHVH. And I invite you to visit our website www.vhvh.org regularly to learn about our growing participants of veterans who have a renewed sense of mission and purpose.
