The Brentwood Art Society invites you to the 18th Annual Brentwood Art, Wine & Jazz Festival, where fine original art, wine tasting, jazz, food and popular special features complement our premier arts festival. It is important that we attract only those artists who have original art for sale. Therefore, the selection committee will jury all entries and not permit any "buy and sell" merchandise or non-art items. If we find these items mixed in with your own work, you will be asked to leave, and you will forfeit your attendance fee.

The Art, Wine & Jazz Festival draws fine art, wine and jazz lovers from throughout East Contra Costa County. A media campaign will be utilized to promote this premier event where original and creative art is offered for sale. We focus our efforts on presenting only the finest artists to our visitors.

- 10'x10' booth area @ \$300 - AGD member 2-10'x10' booth areas @ \$530 (AGD rate)
 10'x10' single booth area @ \$350 non-member 2-10'x10' booth areas @ \$630 (nonmember)

SATURDAY - SUNDAY, JUNE 27-28:

- 10'x10' booth area @ \$280 - AGD member 2-10'x10' booth areas @ \$510 (AGD rate)
 10'x10' single booth area @ \$330 non-member 2-10'x10' booth areas @ \$610 (nonmember)

Early reservations by April 1 can be made with a completed application and a deposit of \$50.00 or more and the balance payable no later than May 15, 2020. Location of each booth will be assigned in order of acceptance to the Festival. Paid fees are non-transferable and non-refundable after acceptance to the Festival. Artists must supply their own 10' x 10' canopy. The deposit must accompany the application(s). Total entry fee must be received no later than May 15th, 2020. No more than two artists may share a single 10' x 10' space. The early deposit is non-refundable. The balance entry fee will be returned if you are not accepted into the festival. A payment of fee, minus the deposit, can be made online BrentwoodArtSociety.org under the Art, Wine and Jazz Festival tab "Online Store".

Photos: Four 4" x 6" photos of your work and one 4" x 6" photo of your display must accompany your application. (Only work similar to what is shown in the photographs will be allowed in the show). Please label the photos with your name and contact information. *Photos not necessary for past year participating vendors unless your work is totally new.*

- Artist Photo ID: Copy of current driver's license.
Sellers Permit: Current California Board of Equalization tax permit required.
 The permit must be available for inspection during the event.

2020 RULES, REQUIREMENTS & OTHER INFORMATION

1. Only artist displaying his or her own original work for sale will be eligible to participate.
2. Artist's work only. Absolutely no imported, manufactured or mass-produced items, kits or anything not made by the artist(s).
3. Accepted artists must be present and exhibit all hours during Saturday and Sunday. No artist representatives are to exhibit in lieu of the artists.
4. Artists are responsible for payment of all applicable taxes to any city, county, state or federal agency.
5. Booths may be left up Saturday evening. General security will be provided for empty displays only. Artists are solely responsible for the security of their own art and personal items.
6. Booth areas are 10' x 10' or 10' x 20'. White canopies unless pre-approved by committee chairman. Booth must be supplied and set up by artist. No festival volunteers are available for assistance with set ups.
7. Trash must be removed at the end of each day to receptacles that will be provided.
8. Set-up:
 - Friday set up should be finished no later than 4 pm Friday afternoon for those approved vendors. We anticipate as many as 3000 guests at the Starry Night Concert.
 - Saturday set up time will be from 7 am to 9:30 am. All artists should be ready for business at 11 am Saturday.
 - Sunday – all artists should be ready for business by 12 noon.

Specific set-up details will be published and sent to accepted artists prior to the event.

Logistics are still being finalized. There will be fencing around the park and the parking lot in front of the Community Center only (no street closures); please be prepared to bring dollies/wagons to ease off/on loading.

9. The Art Vendor Committee volunteers will be available at the Brentwood Art Society booth and on festival grounds at all times to assist you with inquires.
