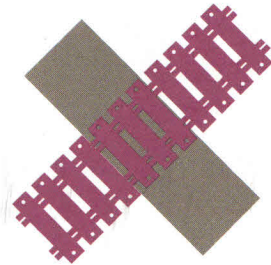
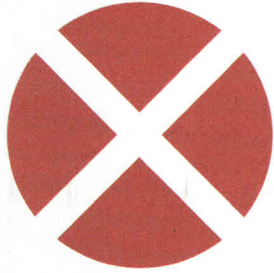


**We need a government in Ottawa that

Instead, since Stephen Harper became Prime Minister, the federal government has:

- Allowed Transport Canada to regularly grant exemptions and exceptions so railways can override safety regulations.
- Cut the railway safety budget by 19% from 2010 through 2014.
- Whitewashed the Lac Mégantic tragedy (where 47 people died at the hands of an irresponsible railway), and failed to implement important regulations to make sure it doesn't happen again.
- Tabled, or threatened to table, back-to-work legislation four times in disputes involving CN Rail and CP Rail.
- Overseen the continued erosion of passenger rail service, including deep cuts to VIA Rail's routes and frequency - halving transcontinental services, and eliminating over 200 jobs for Unifor members.
- Considered destructive changes to federal pension rules, which would allow railways to forcibly convert secure defined benefit pension plans into inferior "target benefit" programs (in which pensioners have no guarantees about the value of their future pensions).
