Meet the Lady Tanetis.

So far, the only known musician of Nekhbet in the temple at Elkab, Upper Egypt.

She received the unique privilege, for a woman of the 25th or 26th Dynasty, of a specially constructed tomb in a prime position of the rock-cut necropolis, with an exquisite wall stela carved next to the entrance. a time which saw lots of changes in Elkab.

What more might the tomb reveal?
