
F, 4/12 MCA DONATIONS – Friday, 4/12 is the last day to turn in donations for MCA.

2019-20 SCHOOL YEAR – We are now accepting applications for new students. Don't miss out on the TWO REGISTRATION REFERRAL PROGRAMS –

- 1) Beatitudes School - Have a new family enroll and both families will receive a \$100 gift card in September.
- 2) Archdiocese of Los Angeles – Go to CatholicEd.com/Refer to earn \$100 off tuition and enter into the iPad raffle.

NEW STUDENT APPLICATIONS – Do you have a TK or K student you are planning to enroll for the 2019-20 school year? Remember to submit an application with required documents to reserve your child's spot.

REGISTRATION FOR 2019-20 – Families will receive a registration packet at the end of April to complete and return by or on our registration day of May 11. Returning families might notice that we restructured the tuition and fees; but there is no increase in the total cost. The \$200 per student application fee is no longer due at registration – it has been added to the yearly tuition. Also, FACTS will now bill the school directly instead of withdrawing the \$50 fee from your personal accounts. This cost has been added to your tuition. The tuition payoff discount has been raised to \$250 for families paying off their fees and tuition by 8/20 so they will not incur the FACTS fee. Please note that the \$500 annual fee is now due at registration (it cannot be added to your FACTS).
