

Earlier today and this evening, the County held their COVID-19 Symposium via Facebook Live and reinforced much of the information that has already been provided here and through other credible sources. New detailed information was offered on the services available through the County and the State. As the situation develops, the Borough continues to adapt in an effort to keep everyone safe:

*The Borough's Senior Bus will continue to operate for essential trips to the grocery store and pharmacy only to serve our senior residents, with no more than 6 riders at a time. Information on the Senior Bus can be obtained by calling 856-582-4766.

* The Public Works building and yard will be closed to the public effective immediately. Please call 856-589-1040 for assistance.

*For the week of March 23, 2020, only trash will be collected. Please do not put out green recycling totes, leaves, brush, or other yard debris for collection. Leaves should not be placed in the street until further notice as the street sweeper will not be in operation at this time.

*Water Department personnel will continue to collect samples and perform other services that can be done outside of the premises or remotely. Inside work at occupied dwellings will be rescheduled for a later date.

*All required inspections for new construction, residential & commercial unoccupied buildings, and any work on the exterior or outside of any occupied building will be performed as usual. Rough inspections for new additions will be done provided no entry to the occupied home or building is required, and commercial rough inspections will be done in unoccupied structures.
