From Interstate 40 East

Follow Interstate 40 East to Wilmington. As you approach Wilmington, turn right onto MLK Parkway/74 West/Downtown. Continue on route to downtown and it will become 3rd Street. Follow 3rd Street for six blocks until you reach Walnut Street. Turn right onto Walnut Street and follow for two blocks. Turn right onto Water Street. Second driveway on left is the entrance to the hotel. The BEST WESTERN PLUS Coastline Inn is located at the very back of the property.

From US 74/76 East

Take Highway 74/76 East to Wilmington. After crossing the Cape Fear Memorial Bridge turn left at the traffic light onto 3rd Street. Follow 3rd Street for 1.5 miles until you reach Walnut Street. Turn left onto Walnut Street then go two blocks. Turn right onto Water Street. Second driveway on left is the entrance to the hotel.
