



Wi-Fi Instructions

Please note that any new device you wish to connect to our Wi-Fi will have to proceed through the steps outlined below. However, once your device is approved, it will automatically connect to this wireless environment for 30 days after each day of use.

Step 1: Turn on your computer's Wi-Fi

Step 2: Search for and connect to "UDSD_Open_Campus"

Step 3: You will be redirected to an **Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) Page** after a **brief stop at the Isolation Page**. Review the AUP and click Agree. **Please note that while your device passes through Isolation, it will be checked for up to date Anti-Virus software. If your device doesn't meet our network requirements, you will not be able to gain access.*



Step 4: Select what type of user you are. If you are a **staff/faculty member**, you should select "UDSD Domain User." You will then be prompted to enter you network login credentials. If you are a **guest user**, you will be asked to supply an email address and a password will AUTOMATICALLY be created for you.



What limitations exist on the guest access Wi-Fi connection?

Connection speed and web filters of all internet content will be placed on UDSD_Open_Campus as required by Board Policy (815) and the Federal Regulations outlined in CIPA. Please be mindful that our district operates with a 35MB internet pipe and has to "share" available connectivity with ALL users.

What do I do if I am having trouble logging onto the guest access Wi-Fi connection with my personal device?

The district has set-up UD_Open_Campus to only allow peripherals which are up to date on their anti-virus software and can be filtered using our BlueCoat application. Your machine and/or handheld device will be denied access to the guest network if detected for suspicious settings/activity. Furthermore, Technology Management Services (TMS), The Office of Technology, and District Technology Representatives, are NOT responsible for troubleshooting on any non-district devices. Please do not request a ticket order be placed for ANY such device.
