Season: By Gun Digest Editors – 12/29/2020

I have linked this article by the JSD Supply. Here is information from the article and I would encourage you to read it from yourself.

Check the Regulations, Laws, and Permits - Nothing will ruin your hunting season quite like forgetting to make sure your permits or licenses are up-to-date and that laws haven't changed. A current big game or small game license is a good place to start. You may need extra licenses or state validations depending on your game of choice.

Check Your Gear - Don't wait until a week before the season to get out your gear and give it a once-over. Check for holes in your soft gear, like your sleeping bag or safety harness. Sharpen your hunting knives and put new batteries in any equipment that needs them. Practice, Practice, Practice - Other essential hunting tips include sighting your rifle or bow and practicing with it. Get to the range early and often to not only avoid crowds but also to ensure you have the skills to pull off a clean shot

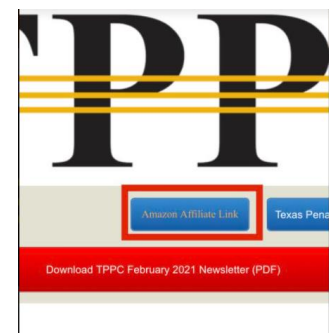
Talk to Landowners and Farmers - A lesser-known hunting tip is that some of the best lands to hunt are privately owned. Long before the season, visit the landowner and ask permission to hunt on their property.

Get in Shape - One of the best hunting tips is to get in shape. Know the area in which you'll be hunting and prepare yourself physically to do so.

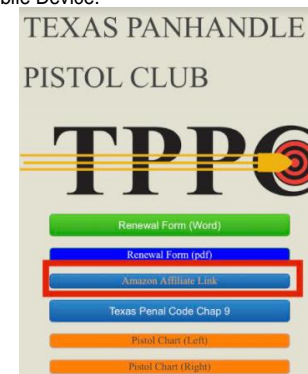

## [House Republican sounds alarm on ATF's gun control moves](#)

Rep. Richard Hudson, a staunch Second Amendment advocate, is sounding off on what he sees as a new, growing threat to gun ownership posed by the federal government.

Republicans have also been vocal about Mr. Chipman's open support for assault weapons bans and his push for universal background checks, two initiatives backed by President Biden.

Mr. Hudson also weighed in against a proposed ATF rule that would regulate some pistol-stabilizing braces, which would aim to reclassify the weapons as short-barreled rifles.

## NICS and Gun Sales

Excerpt from The Gun Feed ([NICS GUN CHECK DATA: 2ND HIGHEST JULY ON RECORD](#))

The month of July 2021 was the second-highest July in terms of federal background checks for gun transfers since the system was established over 20 years ago. The unadjusted figures of 2,860,476 checks conducted through the Federal Bureau of Investigation's National Instant Criminal Background Check System last month, while a 20.9 percent drop from the unadjusted FBI NICS figure of 3,614,192 in July 2020, are still much higher than years prior to that black swan event which was driven by COVID fears, a tense election cycle, and a wave of urban unrest.
