

JIRC Re-opening Bullet Points

- *The Johnston Indoor Recreation Center will re-open on a limited basis on Tuesday, July 7th, at 9:00 AM.
- *Due to the ongoing COVID-19 health crisis and in order to comply with CDC and State of Rhode Island Phase 3 re-opening guidelines, the Indoor Recreation Center will only be available to Johnston residents.
- *Following the established guidelines and maintaining the safety of patrons, employees, and the people of the of Johnston is of utmost importance so we have established the following protocol for facility use.
- *As stated previously, the Johnston Indoor Recreation Center is open to Johnston residents only.
- *Identification will be required, a COVID-19 screening and consent form will have to be completed, and temperatures will be checked prior to entry.
- *Open, single court usage time frames will be from 9-11 AM, 12-2 PM, and 3-5 PM during the week. On Monday, Wednesday, and Friday an additional time frame allowed is from 6-8PM. Weekends are not available at this time.
- *The building will be cleaned and disinfected in between these sessions requiring it to be vacated.
- *Those residents wishing to utilize the recreation center will be assigned a court and are to remain there for the allotted 2 hours unless leaving. Re-entry is not permitted.
- *Participants must bring their own basketball, are not to engage in games with

others, must practice social distancing, and wear face masks/coverings.

*Individual recreation in the form of shooting and dribbling type practice and drills are permitted.

*Due to space constraints and for the safety of users, only fifteen people will be permitted on each court.

*Admission is on a first come, first served basis and no additional entry will be allowed after each court is full or after the first 30 minutes of the two hour play segments. It is therefore recommended to be on time or early for the allotted times and practice 6 feet of social distancing if waiting.

*Hand sanitizer will be available.

*The restrooms and water fountain will not be available at this time so plan accordingly.

*Cones and arrows have been set up to maintain smooth people flow and allow for the stable groups at each court to remain together for each two hour session.

*Your cooperation with this protocol will be of great help to the safety of all involved while using the facility as well as that of the community.
