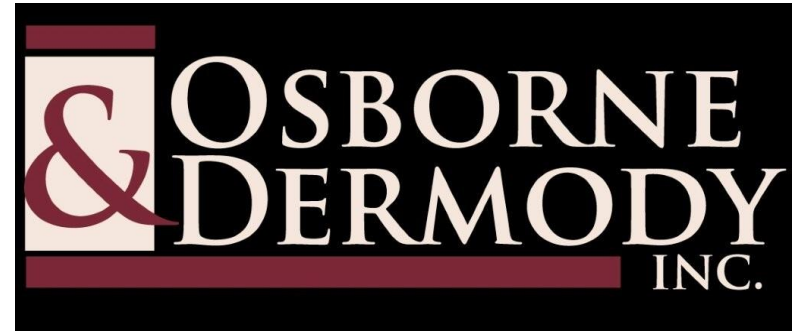

## Measuring your Kitchen

We've provided measuring instructions so you can give us an idea of what your project might look like.

Don't worry about measuring every detail...all measurements will be verified prior to production.

Pretend the room is bare.

You will need graph paper, pencil and a 25' tape measure and you're ready to go!

1. Start measuring from a corner. Continue clockwise around the room until each wall, window and door has been measured.
2. Measure the doors and windows from the outside of the trim.
3. Measure the overall floor to ceiling height, accounting for soffits and beams.
4. Measure the size of existing appliances or provide make and model numbers of new appliances.
