## **CAVITY FREE AT THREE** - FREE dental screening and flouride 'varnish' for **afternoon and full day preschoolers**.

Grand County Public Health is offering this free service on Tuesday, February 26 during normal preschool attendance. If your child does not normally attend on Tuesday and you would like your preschooler to participate, please see Michele for times. If this date does not work for you, this screening will also take place at our Developmental Screenings (details below). If you have a MORNING PRESCHOOLER and would like them to be seen, please see Michele. **Please fill out and return the YELLOW information/permission form that is attached.**



**ILLNESS** - We are having a lot of illness here at the preschool! The staff is working diligently to keep our classrooms sanitized, trying to minimize the spread. If your child is ill, has a fever of 100 or higher, vomiting, diarrhea, coughing excessively, they are contagious. Please keep your child home until they are **symptom free, meaning no fever, vomiting, diarrhea for 24 hours WITHOUT MEDICINE.** Thank you for your help!



**BIRTH - 5 YEARS DEVELOPMENTAL SCREENINGS** - Friday, March 8th, Kremmling Preschool will host the annual developmental screenings. Children birth - 2 years/10 months will be screened from 9am-1130am. Children 2 years/11 months will be screened from 12pm-230pm.
