Ordinance O-2019-27

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH
EXPRESS EMPLOYMENT PROFESSIONALS REGARDING
SEASONAL MAINTENANCE WORK
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village maintenance demands additional general maintenance work during the spring to early fall season extending to October 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Village has additional general maintenance staffing needs during the above-stated season, that is more than what can be covered by those Village employees current employed with the Village to do general maintenance work; and

WHEREAS, Express Employment Professionals has provided a Proposal whereby Amelia Village would utilize Express Employment's staff to fill additional staff needs for general maintenance work pursuant to the attached proposal dated April 16, 2019 ("Proposal"); and

WHEREAS, the Village Council finds that the Proposal as provided would allow the Village's general maintenance staffing needs to be covered for the above-stated season, at rates that are reasonable for the work described; and

WHEREAS, per R.C. 731.141, the Mayor, acting as Village Manager pursuant to Amelia Village Charter Sec. 5.01(F), is authorized to make contracts and purchases without competitive bidding where the amount of the contract does not exceed \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has indicated that the overall cost of the above-stated Proposal is likely to be significantly less than the bidding threshold of R.C. 731.141 and the Village Charter; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio, that;

SECTION I. Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into a contract substantially in conformance with the attached Proposal, by and between Amelia Village, Ohio and Express Employment Professionals, for temporary seasonal work regarding general maintenance services through October 1, 2019.

SECTION II. The Mayor and Village Administration shall limit the use of staff per the attached Proposal to an amount not to exceed the bidding threshold required for contracts pursuant to R.C. 731.141 and the Village Charter.

SECTION III. Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION IV. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village. The reason for such necessity is to allow for immediate use of temporary staffing to the extent necessary to supplement Village General Maintenance staff needed for the spring-fall busy season. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

MS. RUMKE moved to suspend the rules requiring two readings on two separate dates.

MR. FISCHER seconded the motion.
