Deadlines to note below. All times are Eastern time.

- Congress legislation and nomination letters for Student of the Year and Coach of the Year are due to Steve Meadows via email NO LATER than 3/8/17 at 5 PM.
- Registration must be complete online (including all info about all Interp selections) NO LATER than 3/10/17 at 5 PM.
- All Congress and Speech/Debate entry forms including proper signatures are due to Steve Meadows ON PAPER NO LATER than 3/10/17 at 5 PM. You may hand me these at KHSSL State Speech/Debate or mail or fax them to me at Danville High School (859-936-8401).
- All Harlen Hamm and Susan Moore scholarship recommendation letters, fees, signed oratories, and Single Entry Letters of Intent are due at or before Registration on 3/17/17.

Please contact me with any questions you have about the District Tournament. Remember that your students must be members of the NSDA to register for the tournament, that all fees owed to National office must be paid off by Registration, and that your entry quotas are determined by the size of your chapter on 3/10 (so it's to your advantage to keep your student/coach points up to date).
