

LADY REELER'S 2021 WEIGH-IN SLIPS

INSTRUCTIONS

Remember this in on the honor system, but please if you catch something great or odd please take a picture so that we can see it and experience the joy with you!

ALL FIELDS ARE MANDATORY, EXCEPT WHERE STATED

YOUR NAME: Please **PRINT** first and last name

DATE: Be sure your weigh-in slips are submitted according to the time limit listed in the **RULES!!**

SPECIES: List this from our List of Species Rules/Regulations. Please note if you catch a fish not listed, enter it any way. The board makes note of new species, and can add them to revised lists in the future.

WEIGHT: Enter in pounds and ounces.

KEPT OR RELEASED: Not Mandatory – remember only keep what you'll eat! You can fill out a weigh-in slip and release the fish. It still counts!!

LOCATION OF CATCH: Please enter body of water and approximate location. We all have local names for **HOT SPOTS**, but it helps your fellow members to know where they might enjoy some fishing for the same type of quarry.

BODY OF WATER: Please be more specific, other than Long Island Sound. What town are you off of, what wreck, Connecticut

NAME OF BOAT: Please enter the name of the boat the fish was caught from, so that we can share with other members which vessels are hot.

METHOD OF CATCH: What did you use as a lure, what fashion was used to catch your fish.

MAKE & MODEL OF SCALE: Members must use their own scale, which has been verified by the club or acceptable scale as outlined in the Rules and Regulations and the scale used should be available for inspection upon request. This allows us to practice catch and release. Catch and released fish will also be eligible to be entered on the grids.

SIGNATURE: Your signature for the weigh in slip submitted.

DIVISION: Check off the division corresponding to the location and method of your catch.

PLEASE NOTE: FAILURE TO PROPERLY FILL OUT THE WEIGH-IN SLIPS WILL RESULT IN THE SLIP BEING VOID AND FISH NOT BEING ENTERED INTO THE CLUB COMPETITION. ONLY LADY REELER CURRENT WEIGH IN SLIPS WILL BE ACCEPTED AND THEY MUST BE TURNED IN WITHIN 30 DAYS OF CATCH OR IT DOES NOT COUNT.

PHOTOGRAPHS ARE NOW REQUIRED FOR THE FOLLOWING MINIMUM WEIGHTS OF YOUR CATCH, VISIBLE ON YOUR SCALE.

- **WEAKFISH** **5 LBS**
- **PORGIES** **2 LBS 8 OZ.**
- **FLUKE** **6 LBS**
- **BLUE FISH** **8 LBS**
- **SEA BASS** **4 LBS**
- **BLACKFISH** **6 LBS**
- **STRIPED BASS** **20 LBS**
- **COD** **10 LBS**

Please photograph all unusual catches as in Trigger, Mahi, King fish, etc, so that the club can get to see and enjoy them too.
