Listing all of his senior softball individual and team awards would take up a couple pages: at last count, the total was up to over twenty-five! They include numerous MVP, All-Star, All-America and All-World honors as well as his playing key roles as a member of six World Championship teams. Now comes the top honor of them all: David was recently named to the Oklahoma Senior Softball Hall of Fame (OSSHoF).

The OSSHoF has strict criteria for a player to be inducted into its Hall of Fame. Players are awarded points by earning First and Second Team All-America, All-World, All-Tourney and MVP selections. Needless to say, David met and exceeded those requirements. The induction ceremony was held in Mustang, a suburb of Oklahoma City, before a large crowd of players, managers, sponsors and softball executives and their families.

David, with the support of his lovely wife, Anita, has been playing baseball and softball nearly his entire life. From a high school letterman to a junior college All-America to a minor leaguer in the Chicago White Sox chain all the way through adulthood to senior softball, David has been a star on the diamond.

"I was really honored to be inducted into the Hall of Fame," said David. "It was quite a thrill." And David's induction will probably not be the last honor he earns either. He's a current member of the World Champion 70s travel team, sponsored by Pinnacle Physical Therapy. It's likely more awards and championships are just around the corner.
