Lease Reminder: Allowing a banned person in your home, or unauthorized persons to stay/visit overnight for more than 14 consecutive days, WILL jeopardize your housing. This is a major lease violation and could result in eviction. If you are unsure if someone is banned, it is best to ask the front office. If you wish to add someone to your lease, paperwork and Criminal Background Checks must be completed. Until applicants are authorized, they may NOT live in Whittier Falls housing.
