

General Flying Guidelines			
Item	Fixed Wing Zone (FWZ)	Drone Zone (DZ)	No Fly Zone
Flight Area	Fixed Wing Aircraft must fly in the FWZ specified area extending from the runway over the riverbed.	Drones must fly in the (DZ) specified area extending from the pig pit to the road to Trabuco Flyers.	No flying over structure or flight boxes or spectators.
Flight Pattern:	Take off in a South West direction, Fly in a clockwise pattern over the road and riverbed, land from the North East direction.	Flight pattern is not defined and often changes based on the setup of the day. Freestyle and race flight is permissible	
Exceptions:	Drones may fly in the FWZ area when there are NO Fixed wing aircraft flying and must fly from the flight box		No exceptions, the No Fly Zone is strictly off limits for the safety of Pilots, Spectators, and structure.
Dotted Line:	The dotted line on the map shows the approximate property line, flying is permissible however, pilots should refrain from occupying the area to the left of the dotted line		N/A
Special Circumstances:	In the event there is a special circumstance, such as prevailing winds, there may be a temporary need to change the one or more of the items above. Special Circumstances will be communicated from Trabuco Flyers Staff in efforts to promote a safe flying atmosphere for all members.		N/A
Communication:	In the event you encounter a situation where your aircraft is unresponsive or encounters a problem, it's your responsibility to clearly communicate to other pilots and spectators the nature of your issue and any exceptions needed to maintain a safe flying environment.		N/A
