 and there's not any reason, no, not the least, why I shouldn't be one too.

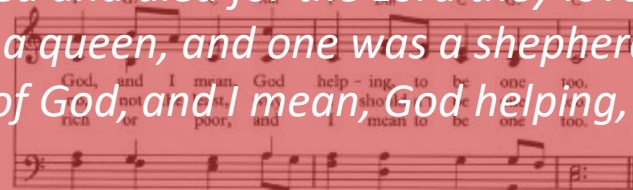
3. They lived not only in ages past; there are hundreds of thousands still.
