



DON'T DO WHAT They do Matthew 23:1-12

- 1) They shut the Kingdom of Heaven (Matt. 23:13)
- 2) Making a son of hell (v. 15)
- 3) Swear by temple, not in heaven (v. 22)
- 4) Neglect important matters (justice, mercy and faithfulness, v.23)
- 5) Inside full of greed and self indulgence (v.25)
- 6) Full of hypocrisy and wickedness (v.28)
- 7) Testify against yourselves as you decorate the graves of righteous (v.31)


