We currently have over 75 dues paying members. The Dayton Chapter:

- Provides Penn Staters the opportunity to get together for common purpose
- Serves as a communication link between the Alumni and the University
- Aids the University with local area functions and promotes Penn State in the local community
- Assists in identifying and recruiting scholars, and providing scholarships thereto
- Provides assistance to the Chapter constituents in various ways.

Although our Chapter is primarily a social organization, we also attempt and succeed in working with various community organizations to assist them in achieving their goals/projects. Our activities are varied to meet the needs of the members, and one can participate as much as one desires. We have an annual banquet in the spring with guest speakers from the University. Community Service = Channel 16 Auction

Each year in April, ThinkTV, aka Channel 16, does an on-air auction. It is their largest fund raiser of the year. This is a very large event involving hundreds of volunteers. Without volunteers, the station could not have this event. This year the auction is Monday, April 18 through Saturday, April 23. It is held at the TV station in downtown Dayton, 110 S Jefferson St. This is a live on-air auction, with groups of items shown and described. Viewers phone in their bids. Bids are sorted and the high bidder is selected. The high bidder is called to inform them. Groups of items are sold like this throughout the evening. This year the Penn State alumni group is again helping in the "Confirmation Section". We help call the high bidders, get their information, and make sure they know how to pick up their item. The confirmation volunteers are a dedicated group that put in a long night, arriving at 6:00 PM and staying until every high bid has been confirmed, usually finishing around 11:30 or midnight.

Our annual Student Send-Off will be held on Wednesday, August 3, at the home of Bob & Edie Kreider.
