What Is the Sign Of The Cross, And Why Do We Catholics Make It?

In the Sign of the Cross, we profess the deepest mysteries of the Christian Faith: The Trinity—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit--and the saving work of Christ on the Cross on Good Friday. The combination of the words and the action are a creed—a statement of belief. We mark ourselves as Christians through the Sign of the Cross.

THE OLDEST CHURCH IN THE UNITED STATES

San Miguel Chapel in Santa Fe, New Mexico. It was originally built around 1610 by the Tlaxcalan Indians under the guidance of the Franciscans. The chapel is often referred to as the oldest church in the United States (excluding Puerto Rico), though it is likely that little of the original structure is still present. The church was rebuilt twice, once in the mid to late 17th century, and again in 1710 following the Pueblo Revolt.
