Supervisor May called the board meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. at the town hall located at 3529 Rt. 20A, Warsaw, New York.

Supervisor May opened with the Pledge of Allegiance; all were thanked for attending the meeting. [There were no questions or comments from the audience.]

Zoning Officer Report: Planning Board is working on two new land separations. Had a phone conversation with Wade and Brian from Invenergy, will meet the end of September. Mr. Elhage has met the requirements set forth, his check for payment of attorney fees has been received. Discussed the roads off Royce – King, Mr. Roggow states that we must not work on them for 3 years then we can abandon road.

Highway Superintendent Report:

Have been helping Attica pave, doing some shoulder work, helping Gainesville and oil / stone some roads. We found more water on centerline hill, tile by creek, hopefully will be good. Have a draft agreement – easement with Mr. Kibler. Working on culverts.

Town Clerk Report: Our Town website visits for August was 1293. The Towns total revenue for the month of August 2020 was \$1,574.00, \$228.00 for dog licenses, \$420.00 for zoning fees, DEC - \$791.00 and Marriage-40.00. We had 29 dog renewal licenses and 4 new license. To the general fund, \$543.11, Dogs were 27.00, \$35.00 late fees, \$43.61-DEC, Marriage-\$17.50 and \$420.00 for zoning. We disbursed \$210.00 to Wyoming County, \$51.00 to Ag and Markets for dogs, \$22.50 to NYSDOH and \$747.39 to DEC.

Correspondence: No new correspondence.

Spectrum (Mark M.) discussed where the company continues to work on lines and they have about 150 houses set up at this time. In April they will be working on lines north of 20A. Need to update the franchise agreement. He discussed plans for the future with Orangeville Town.

Supervisor May opened the Public Hearing on the Warsaw Fire Contract on a motion by Mr. Herman, seconded by Mr. Flint at 0730pm.
