Getting an extension on the permit on Royce Road, the culvert collapsed. Matt's truck needs new lines for the box, \$3,500, maybe a little less, there is a seal pump issue. Working on patching and started mowing. Oil and stone cost is going up to \$400/mile. We have been doing driveways for residents. New 1- wheeler came in, will be ready maybe be by September 1st. There was discussion regarding shinny blacktop of binder and sealer.

Supervisor May opened the Public Hearing on Land subdivision and separation. There were no questions from the audience. Ms. May read a card of thanks from Wyomco.

Registrar-\$120.00 and marriage \$35.00. We disbursed \$160.00 to Wyoming County, \$41.00 to Ag and Markets for dogs, DEC-\$23.62 and NYSDOH-\$45.00.
