Pastoral to our clergy, religious, seminarians, and beloved faithful of St. Josaphat Eparchy, and to all people of good will everywhere in the world.

The Ascension of Our Lord as depicted in the Acts of the Apostles calls to our attention a beautiful and deeply profound scene. Upon seeing the Lord ascending into the heavens, the Apostles keep their gaze fixed on Christ and are unmoved. St. Luke writes: "And while they were gazing into heaven as he went, behold, two men stood by them in white robes, and said, 'Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into heaven?
