What can you recycle?

The Hunterdon County Solid Waste Management Plan requires the following items to be recycled:

WHAT	WHEN/How
Aluminum & B-Metal Cans	Tuesday Recycling
Glass Bottles and Jars (Clear & Colored)	Tuesday Recycling
Cardboard & brown paper bags	Tuesday Recycling (No waxed containers)
Newspapers, Magazines, Junk Mail, Papers	Tuesday Recycling *Shredded paper not recyclable)
Plastic Bottles (#1-7)	Tuesday Recycling
Computer Equipment, Propane Tanks, Florescent Lighting Tubes, Motor Oil, Televisions, Car Batteries	Hunterdon County Division of Solid Waste and Recycling (Check website for Dates & Times)
Laser/Ink Jet Cartridges	Hampton Elementary School
Leaves Yard Waste**	Collected from Curbside by Borough October to Dec. Please check website for specific dates) Before or after these dates leaves **must be bagged and tagged with Extra Bag stickers
Scrap Metal and White Goods (Large Appliances	Contact DPW for an Appointment for Pick Up and to establish required number of Extra Bag stickers.
ALL RECYCLABLES GO INTO THE SAME CONTAINER.	CARDBOARD SHOULD BE TIED.
<b>***Containers should not weigh more than 50 pounds***</b>	Recycling is collected on Tuesday except when Monday is a holiday then Garbage is collected on Tuesday and Recycling on Wednesday.
