\*It is strongly advised that you send in your registration form with your deposit as soon as possible. On January 3, 2018 registration is open to the public. If you have not signed up prior to this date there is no guarantee that your child will be able to be placed in a class as each class has a maximum amount of children allowed according to the age level and room size.
