Our school is about to take part in a very special, for the first time ever communitywide shared reading event! Welcome to SHES's "One School One Book" Summer Edition! Thanks to grant monies from the Community Foundation of the Eastern Shore, we have another OSOB to share!

Just like in February, every family will receive a copy of the same book, and will be asked to read it together at home over the next few weeks. This summer our selection is E.B. White's classic, *Stuart Little*.

Today, your child received a copy of *Stuart Little* at a special school-wide assembly introducing the program and the book. Along with the book, he/she received a reading schedule so that you can keep up at home. Generally, you will be asked to read about 15 minutes every other night. Additionally, we will be hosting two "Reading Meet Ups" to encourage summer reading. The meet-ups are scheduled for Wednesday, July 3<sup>rd</sup> and Monday, July 15<sup>th</sup> at SHES. Meet-ups begin at 9:00 and will last for approximately 45 minutes.

Additionally, your child will receive a response packet and will be invited to answer drawing and writing prompts to encourage and reward attentive reading. Please complete packets and hold on to them! A completed packet is your child's ticket to the Summer Reading Water Slide incentive in September!

I know that you'll enjoy this special summer reading time with your child. I hope to talk with both you and your student sometime in the days to come about *Stuart Little* and the adventures he has. "When a whole school reads a book, there's a lot to talk about." With your help, we can build a Community of Readers at our school. I hope you enjoy this special edition on OSOB!!
