Trojans celebrate Homecoming, Win streak stands at 19!

Jenks celebrated Homecoming in style Friday night, whipping Bartlesville 62-24 and concluding their season schedule unbeaten. The Trojans head into the playoffs next week with a perfect 9-0 season and are looking for a second straight state title.

The Trojans amassed almost 500 yards of offense with 300 of that in passing. The state's number one 6A team also scored three touchdowns in less than a minute during the game and rolled over Bartlesville. Bartlesville ended their season 2-5 in district play and 3-7 overall.

Jenks was tied with Bartlesville 7-7 early on but then broke the game wide open midway through the first quarter when they scored three touchdowns in 42 seconds that took only five plays. Bartlesville scored on an 80-yard run by Johnny Rivera. As a result, four touchdowns were scored in less than a minute.

Trojan RB Freddie Carolina led the Trojans with 202 yards on 19 carries and two touchdowns. The first touchdown was in the first half as Carolina only carried the ball once in the second half. He racked up 100 yards in the first quarter and scored on a five yard run after setting Jenks up with a 58-yard run.

Jenks' second score was set up by DB Jesse Meyer when he blocked a Bartlesville punt. Carolina scored on a 14-yard play later from the one putting Jenks up 14-7. Then, the scoring rally began.

Jenks tried an onside kick and it was recovered by Trojan Sam Almohandis at the Bartlesville. QB Nick Sidorakis threw for a TD to starting QB Andrew Brewer making the score 21-7. Jenks Lamkin then picked off a pass on Bartlesville's second play and returned it to the Bartlesville. Cutten then scored on a pass from Brewer and the score stood at 28-7.

Bartlesville then scored on an 80-yard run by Rivera and Jenks followed with a 4-yard run by Brewer. Brewer finished with 109 yards and three touchdowns while backup QB Sidorakis ended with 5 for 6.
