P-BOb has become legendary for his lyrical, mesmerizing, and captivating oratory. I thought it would be fun to dig up reactions surrounding some of his speeches as well as some comments about his style. Some of these are P-BOb's J-STRAPS reciting how they "came to Obama", or their inspired emotions following some of his speeches. Others are "experts" trying to analyze his speeches, style or the public's reactions. Others are observers and critics.

Following the quoted statements below, I provide a list of individuals who may have said or written these things. Every quote will have its source on that list, and an individual may have provided more than one quote. But not all entries on the list of possible sources will be associated with a quote. Each quote is numbered. Each possible source is lettered. A space is provided next to the quote for your answer, should you decide to "give it a go" and guess the source. The correct answers are listed at the end so it is perfectly acceptable to cheat. Here goes:

Quotations

- _ 1. "(He is) 'The One' (because) we need politicians who know how to be the truth" (and to help us) "evolve to a higher plane".
- 2. "One of the secrets of being a glib talker is not getting hung up over whether what you are saying is true, and instead giving your full attention to what is required by the audience and the circumstances of the moment without letting facts get in your way and cramp your style. Obama has mastered that art. Con men understand that their job is not to use facts to convince skeptics but to use words to help the gullible to believe what they want to believe the promise of something for nothing.
