March 2016 Minutes: Motion made by Yarger and support by Caris to approve the minutes of the March 2016 Meeting as printed. All in favor and the motion carried.

Calls for Service Dispatched: March 2016 stats were reviewed and discussed. Text to 9-1-1 stats has been added to the monthly report.

Yankee Springs Fire Department:

At this time, the first responders are not always answering so this is not working as well as it should be. This also creates extra work and anxiety for our dispatchers. Phyllis will have a discussion with Dr. Scarf regarding this.

Yankee Springs Fire will need to add all call to their pagers for the nightly fire test.

SMPA-South Michigan PSAP Alliance: A total of six bids were received. Four of the bids are for the Vesta 9-1-1 Airbus system. There was one bid for a Viper system and one bid for a Motorola system. We will be using a matrix to score the bids. The low bid is from AT&T at \$507,000; however they left of a couple of required items from their bid. The high bid was from Carousel at \$786,000.00. Bids include a six (6) year maintenance agreement.

We will be holding three demos to see all three different products.

Blue Alert Policy: This policy spells out the criteria to meet, how to alert and who makes the alert in the event of a serious injury or death of a law enforcement officer.

Motion was made by Pratt and support by Caris to take the Blue Alert Police to the Administrative Board for approval. All in favor and the motion carried.

Miscellaneous:

Nena Conference “Young Hero Award”:

A Barry County 10 year- old boy will receive this award on May 23 at the Nena Conference for his call to 9-1-1 and his calm demeanor in helping his father in a medical emergency.
