

Prophetic Portraits of the Messiah

The Old Testament has much to say about Jesus Christ. The following outline will prove helpful in learning more about our Savior.

Shortly before his ascension back to heaven, Jesus declared: "Everything must be fulfilled that is written about me in the Law of Moses, the Prophets and the Psalms." (Lk. 24:44) This three-fold division of the Old Testament was common to the Jews. The "law" referred to the first five books.

The "prophets" included Joshua, Judges, Samuel, and Kings, as well as the formal prophets - Isaiah, Jeremiah, Ezekiel - and the Twelve, Hosea through Malachi.

The "psalms" (also called Holy Writing) encompassed all the poetical literature, Ruth, Ester, Chronicles, Ezra-Nehemiah and Daniel.

More than 300 prophecies pointing to the Messiah are scattered throughout these writing. Note some of these under the three classifications cited.
