BAPTISM STIPEND - \$25.00 - Baptisms are celebrated by appointment (after a Baptism Preparation Course has been completed).

BAPTISM PREPARATION: The baptism of a child is a very important event in the life of the child, the child's family, and the parish community. To help parents enter more fully into the celebration of their child's baptism, St. Joseph's Parish offers a Baptism Preparation Course by appointment. Parents along with godparents are expected to attend the Baptism Preparation Course before the baptism of the child. Please call the Parish Office to register.

MARRIAGE STIPEND - \$200.00 - Please allow at least six months between the time of contacting the Parish and the date of the Marriage. A Marriage Preparation Course is required.

FUNERAL STIPEND - \$200.00 - St. Joseph's Parish has a Bereavement Committee which will contact you to coordinate the funeral services.

AUGUST 8 - MEMORIAL OF SAINT DOMINIC, PRIEST: Dominic founded the Order of Preachers (Dominicans) in 1216. Priests of this Order were highly educated and could be sent where the need was greatest, fighting heresy and preaching the importance of the Sacraments. Dominic died in 1221, was canonized in 1234, and is a patron saint of the Dominican Republic (named after the Latin word for Sunday), astronomers, scientists, and falsely accused persons.

AUGUST 9 - MEMORIAL OF SAINT TERESA BENEDICTA OF THE CROSS, VIRGIN AND MARTYR: In 1891, Edith Stein was born into a large Jewish family in Breslau, Germany (present-day Poland). A remarkable student, she received her doctorate at age 25. She was drawn to Catholicism and was baptized in 1922, spending the next 12 years teaching at Catholic institutions. Although she was a convert to Catholicism, Edith always acknowledged her Jewish heritage and saw the Cross as her destiny. In 1934 she joined the Carmelites in Cologne, taking the name Teresa Benedicta of the Cross. However, by 1938, Nazi antisemitism was widespread, and in 1942 Edith was arrested by the Gestapo and deported to Auschwitz where she died in a gas chamber. She was canonized in 1998 and is co-patron of Europe.

AUGUST 10 - FEAST OF SAINT LAWRENCE, DEACON, MARTYR: Lawrence suffered martyrdom in 258. A defender of the Church in Rome, he was one of the most venerated Roman martyrs of the early Church and is a patron of Rome. He is mentioned in the Canon of the Mass.

AUGUST 13 - MEMORIAL OF SAINT PONTIAN, POPE, AND SAINT HIPPOLYTUS, PRIEST, MARTYRS: During a period of persecution, both Pontian, who had succeeded Pope Urban I in 230, and Hippolytus, who was a priest, a well-known scholar and theologian, were exiled to the unhealthy mines of Sardinia. It was there that they met each other. Hippolytus had rebelled against the Church, but was reconciled through the efforts of Pontian. Hippolytus wrote many works, including a prayer on which our Eucharistic Prayer II is based. Both Pontian and Hippolytus died a martyr's death.
