Svenddal, a Twin Cities journeyman player for over thirty years in rock, blues, jazz and country bands; Terry Isachsen, the best utility guitarist in the Twin Cities; JJ (Jon James) Benson is a multi-instrumentalist; Jim Steinworth, classically-trained pianist; and Clay Williams on the guitar.
