DESCRIPTION: This is the last one of the iconic Ben Pearson Palomino's that I have in my collection. Lighter draw weight target bow. Great looking and performing recurve. Brazilian Rosewood and contrasting laminate riser. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Double-sided overlay tips. Beveled (bi-radial) arrow shelf. Factory installed stabilizer insert (1/4"). Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No dings or cracks. There was a little chip in the arrow shelf that was filled with wood epoxy (see pic on last page). No crazing or stress cracks; A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. A previous owner had spilled some blue dye on the riser. I was able to get a lot of it out but there is some residue remaining (see pics). Decal is in good condition. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow sold for \$125 in 1967, which translates to \$1,027 in 2021 inflation adjusted dollars.




