AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO Ordinance O-2017-36

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CONTRACT WITH ROBERT HEINTZELMAN AS AN AUXILIARY CANINE POLICE OFFICER FOR AMELIA VILLAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Robert Heintzelman was appointed as an auxiliary canine police officer by Ordinance No. 2015-19, effective as of March 24, 2015;

WHEREAS, Officer Heintzelman has performed his duties in a professional and commendable manner and it is in the best interest of the Village to increase the hourly wage Officer Heintzelman.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio, that:

SECTION I. That the Canine Officer Employment Agreement shall be modified, in accordance with attached Exhibit "A"

SECTION II. Any section of Ordinance 2015-19 in conflict with this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

SECTION III. Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION IV. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village. The reason for such necessity is to ensure that Officer Heintzelman compensated at competitive rates, in order retain his services. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
