## **Rules & Regulations**

- Each student competitor will receive 1 participation award. (students dancing in multiple events will receive 1 participation award) Formation Teams will receive 1 trophy/award to the participating studio and each formation participant will receive a placement ribbon.
- Showdance Championship and Multi Dance Events will award  $1^s$ ,  $2^{rd}$ , and  $3^{rd}$  place.
- The top Male, Female, Am/Am Couple, Junior and Showdance will be invited to perform an honor dance during the evening session.
- All participating professionals are invited to take part in our "Professional Variety Show" please contact DanceSport Academy for additional information.
- Single & Multi Dance Competition Events: Any student entering will be competing against those within the age, level, and style of event entered and given a placement from  $1^{st}$ - $3^{rd}$  (e.g. C/ Bronze/ Rhythm)
- <u>Proficiency</u> Single & Multi Dance Events: Any student entering will be given a score from 1-100 based on the level entered, and will not be scored in comparison to any other competitor.
- Student may enter in both Proficiency and Competition in any single or multi dance event.
- There is no limit to the amount of single or multi dance events a student may enter.
- Costumes at all ages and levels are permitted but not required.
- All routines are limited to 3 minutes, including walk on/walk off.
