




# PATTERN 2 LOPE TOWARD




Begin on left lead. At the center, without stopping or breaking gait, begin pattern facing toward the judge. Refer to rule 20.6

- Beginning on the left lead, complete 3 circles to the left.
   The first one large and fast, the second small and slow, the third large and fast. Change leads at the center of arena.
- Complete 3 circles to the right. The first one large and fast, the second small and slow, and the third large and fast. Change leads at the center of arena.
- Continue loping to run down. Run to far end past the marker to a sliding stop.
- Complete 3½ spins to the left.
- Run to far end past marker to a sliding stop.
- Complete 3½ spins to the right.
- Run past center marker to a sliding stop. Back at least 10 feet. Hesitate to complete pattem.


## PATTERN 5



This pattern works best when the exhibitor and cattle enter from the same end of arena.

- Start at end of arena. Run past center marker, stop, and back at least 10 feet. 1/4 turn to left.
- Complete two circles to left.
  The first circle large and fast,
  the second circle small and
  slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
- Complete two circles to the right. The first circle small and slow, the second circle large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
- Continue around end of arena without breaking gait or changing leads, run down center of arena past end marker, execute a square sliding stop.
- Complete 3½ spins to the right.
- Rundown center of arena past end marker, execute a square sliding stop.
- Complete 3½ spins to the left. Hesitate to complete pattern.


- **Extended** trof

- 5. Trot
- 6. Lope right lead
- 7. Extended lope right lead
- 8. Collect lope and change leads (simple or flying)
- 9. Lope left lead
- 10. Stop and back
- II. 1/2 turn right 12. Trot
