Come celebrate with the Templeton Historical Museum as it joins Smithsonian Magazine’s 15th Annual Museum Day. Templeton Museum has fantastic artifacts from the early days of Templeton. In addition to opening the Museum House, the railroad depot and the old blacksmith’s shop will also be available for tours. The depot has many railroad artifacts dating back to Templeton’s founding in 1886 as a railroad terminus. The depot also houses a 1927 Ford Model T and the original fire cart purchased in 1909 by the Templeton Fire District. In the blacksmith’s shop, visitors will be able to view the recently restored 1932 Templeton School Bus and the 1934 Templeton Fire Truck in addition to displays showing the workings of local blacksmiths dating back to 1917. Refreshments will be served and all attendees will receive a FREE gift.
