Ordinance O-2016-39

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH TASER
INTERNATIONAL, INC. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, The Village is in need of new conducted electrical weapons for use by the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, TASER International, Inc. is willing and able to provide TASER conducted electrical weapons as needed and requested by the Village;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio that:

SECTION I: Village Council accepts the recommendation of the Police Chief that the Village contract with TASER International, Inc., for the purchase of TASER conducted electrical weapons

SECTION II: The Mayor and the Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized and directed to execute the Master Services and Purchasing Agreement and on behalf of the Village to secure the necessary Tasers from TASER International, Inc., substantially in form attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SECTION III: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to approve this ordinance at the earliest possible time, in order to acquire Tasers for the Village, so that the Police Department may begin using the new devices as soon as possible; thereby providing for the public's safety. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, the ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

SECTION IV: Village Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

D. Campbell moved to suspend the rules requiring three readings on three separate dates.
