

There are pamphlets in the foyer so you can also pray at home. This is a powerful novena requested by Jesus himself to St. Faustina.

My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

"Alleluia, Alleluia, the Lord has truly risen as He said, Alleluia."

This is our traditional greeting of the Easter Sunday morning, the entire Lenten journey was leading us to this great event—the Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ from the death he endured on Good Friday. Jesus Christ now lives forever.

The Holy Week that started on Palm Sunday-with the commemoration of Christ's triumphant entry into Jerusalem.

Holy Thursday with the institution of the Eucharist and the Ministerial Priesthood Good Friday—celebration of the Passion of our Lord.
