








### Kadie Meadows

# Artist of the Month



My interest in stained glass started at an early age, always being mesmerized by the beauty of the stained glass in the historic churches of Charleston, SC, and Notre Dame de Paris' rose windows. Standing in the colored rays inside that dark medieval cathedral made me want to learn more about the stained glass art form. I taught myself how to cut glass using hand carbide tools, which is the most challenging part of working with glass. I use the same techniques of the oldworld masters, using lead came and hand foiled edges. Historically, pictorial stained glass windows of medieval times told biblical stories, often forthose who could not read. I too tell stories in my glass work, but with a different purpose. I find inspiration from traveling, nature, and past experiences. Looking around my gallery, you will notice most of my pieces are animals, fish, insects, and plants. I use other mediums in combination with glass including copper tubing, tin wire, vintage silver, agate, and beach glass.
